Exercising power under section 18 (1) of Finance Act 2077, meeting of the Council of Ministers held on 15 Ashwin 2077 (1/10/2020) reduced the excise duty on electric vehicles by 80% to 25%. The customs duty and VAT remains unchanged. Revised excise duty is as follows.

<b>Battery capacity</b>	<b>Previous Excise Duty</b>	New Excise duty
50 KW	30%	6%
50-100 KW	40%	10%
100-150 KW	50%	15%
150-200 KW	60%	45%
200-300 KW	70%	52.2%
Above 300 KW	80%	60%
